

The Four calls – Every believer has calls from the Scripture to share the Gospel, the Good News. These four calls should compel us to share the gospel.

The first call is the call from **above**

Jesus said to them, ‘Go into all the world and share the good news with everyone. Mark 16:15 Also from Isaiah, Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, ‘Whom shall I send? And who will go for us? Then Isaiah said, Here I am Lord, send me. Isaiah 6:8

We have the call from above to share the gospel.

The second call- the call from **below**

The call from those suffering in hell. When both the rich man and Lazarus died, the rich man went to hell and Lazarus went to Abraham’s side. The rich man said to Abraham “I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my father’s house, for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.” Luke 16:27 - 28 There is a voice we must of those that are suffering in hell, that is the call from below.

The third call – the call from **inside**

the voice that comes within every individual

Paul said, “Yet when I preach the gospel, I cannot boast, for I am compelled to preach. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel! 1 Corinthians 9:16

Every one of us should feel the call from within ourselves to go out and share the gospel once we know Christ.

The forth call the call from **outside** – the calling from Others

“During the night, Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, ‘Come over to Macedonia and help us.’” Acts 16:9

Those who do not know Christ want you to tell them the good news.

Therefore, each and every one of us should be capable of hearing these 4 calls, requesting us to go and spread the gospel.
