## **Core Task Training is simple and Exponential**

These are the parts, we are working on a reproduceable strategy for each of these parts, that facilitates the kind of movement that we see in Acts 13-21.

**Abiding**- self feeders on Word of God, corporate feeders

**Entry**- not just how we enter into new place, but how every believer is equipped and encouraged to take the gospel to the unreached.

**Evangelism** – Every believer telling my story, his story, testimony and simple gospel presentation.

**Discipleship-** We will look at 7 commands, Sword method inductive Bible study.

Repent and believe

Be baptised

Love, fellowship

**Lords Supper** 

Pray

Give

Go and make disciples.

**Church Planting-** house church like we see in the NT that church that meets in Aquilla and Priscilla's house, the church that meets in Nympha's house

**Exit** – Raising up the local believers to continue the work locally and move to the next place.

We want every part of this strategy to be simple and reproducible. We want each part to lead to the next part.

Like the Water buffalo herder, who must train their community. The training must be reproduceable. It will need to be simple t be transferable.

like what happened in the Garo hills. A villager couple heard the gospel in the valley and brought the gospel to the hills and it spread.

Simple Albert Einstein, keep it as simple as possible and not simpler

2 Timothy 2:2 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.

Give attention to generations not just total number.

Additional to exponential

The core task training is not for your but for you to train others new to faith. Training for Trainers, Train trainers who train trainers who train.

**Mark 4:8**, NIV: "Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, some multiplying thirty, some sixty, some a hundred times.

## **Story Grain of rice.**

Ephesians 4:11-12 – The leader quips the believers.

So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup> to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up
