## Evangelism

We want to create an environment where we build a DNA. An ethos of abundant evangelism. How many of my people heard the gospel today? That's the question and we want to be giving abundant evangelism.

If you sow sparingly you reap sparingly. If you sow abundantly you reap abundantly. Therefore with the core task training we want to turn evangelism into a practicum. This is not about head knowledge. This is about the gospel shared those who need to hear the good news.

So when we teach them to share the gospel we model it. We go out with them during the training to share the gospel. This is part of the model, assist, watch and leave pattern. We go out with them and share the gospel in the training.

We have taught them the Hand Gospel that is simple and reproducible. We have taught them with such simplicity that they could now train the new believer in this method on the spot to share the gospel with their friends and family.

We have taught them how to give their testimony in a very simple way that could be shared in just a few minutes. During the training we go out with them and we're sharing the gospel together in groups of two. It's so simple that those that accept the gospel they could be reproducing it they could be sharing the gospel with others.

It's a challenge to go out during a training and share the gospel, but it becomes the highlight of the training. When people come back and share that there was a response they are very encouraged. Especially when in a household several members of the household come to faith. Then they can use this as a training tool for what to do next.

We can teach them how we begin to disciple this household that has come to faith in Christ. How we disciple them as a group. How we teach them the Seven Commands so that these new believers worship and understand and practice baptism and the Lord's supper. This becomes a disciple group that is in a position to move right into becoming a reproducing house church. So the practicum of evangelism is very central to the Core Task training.

Now we come to the oikos list. The list of family of friends that we looked at during entry. We need to ask who needs to hear the gospel? So after we finish going out in the practicum share the gospel we make our oikos list. Who are we going to share the gospel with? if we could list 100 people then list 100 people. Then we determine who are the five top priority people who we will share with this week. We make this list prayerfully to determine who the Lord is leading us to share the gospel with.

At the end of this training session when we come back together we will share about the experience of sharing the gospel with those five. Already they have learned the 4 calls. We trained every believer we knew in how to share the 4 calls. Now we're asking them to share teach the hand gospel to everyone we already trained in 4 calls.

Remember we said if there were 30 in the training group and they trained 20 each those 600 would be sharing the 4 calls and training them to share with others. Then those 600 trained 10 each for a total of 6,000 trained to share the 4 calls. That's in our just our illustration of 2 Timothy 2:2 generational growth. It is a best case scenario that everyone follow the same chain of those 30 training the 20 for the hand gospel and those 600 training those ten people each for 6000 people challenging them all to share the gospel five times each that 30,000 people a week.

Look back to the questions, how many of my people heard the gospel this week? We know that there wouldn't be 100% of the of the 30 that have trained 20 who trained 10. There wouldn't be 100% at the 6000 sharing the 4 calls and hand gospel, but we also know that the some among them becomes super sowers.

Some do multiply 10 times or 20 times or more than we've asked them to do. So we want to create an ethos of abundant of evangelism that so many people hear the gospel. So that we share with families and whole households come to faith. Then our disciples are beginning to start new house churches. This is what the core task training is about. Starting new work so you can walk them through discipleship and teaching the seven commands and the house church reproduces.

As you continue on the training and the more people come to faith there are more who are hungry for what to do next. They want to know how to disciple these new believers. They want to know how they could become a discipleship group that becomes a new house church.

With this DNA we are prepared to see a New Testament pattern church that multiplies. So this is the of evangelism training. It is a key part of the Core task training.
